Since the anticoagulant is returned to the donor along with blood components that are not being collected, it can bind the calcium in the donor's blood and cause hypocalcemia. Knowing what to expect before, during, and after you donate can help you prepare for the process.

Donors are examined for signs and symptoms of diseases that can be transmitted.

Blood banks in the United States may be required to label the blood if it is from a therapeutic donor, so some do not accept donations from donors with any blood disease. A 'directed' donation is when a person, often a family member, donates blood for transfusion to a specific individual.
